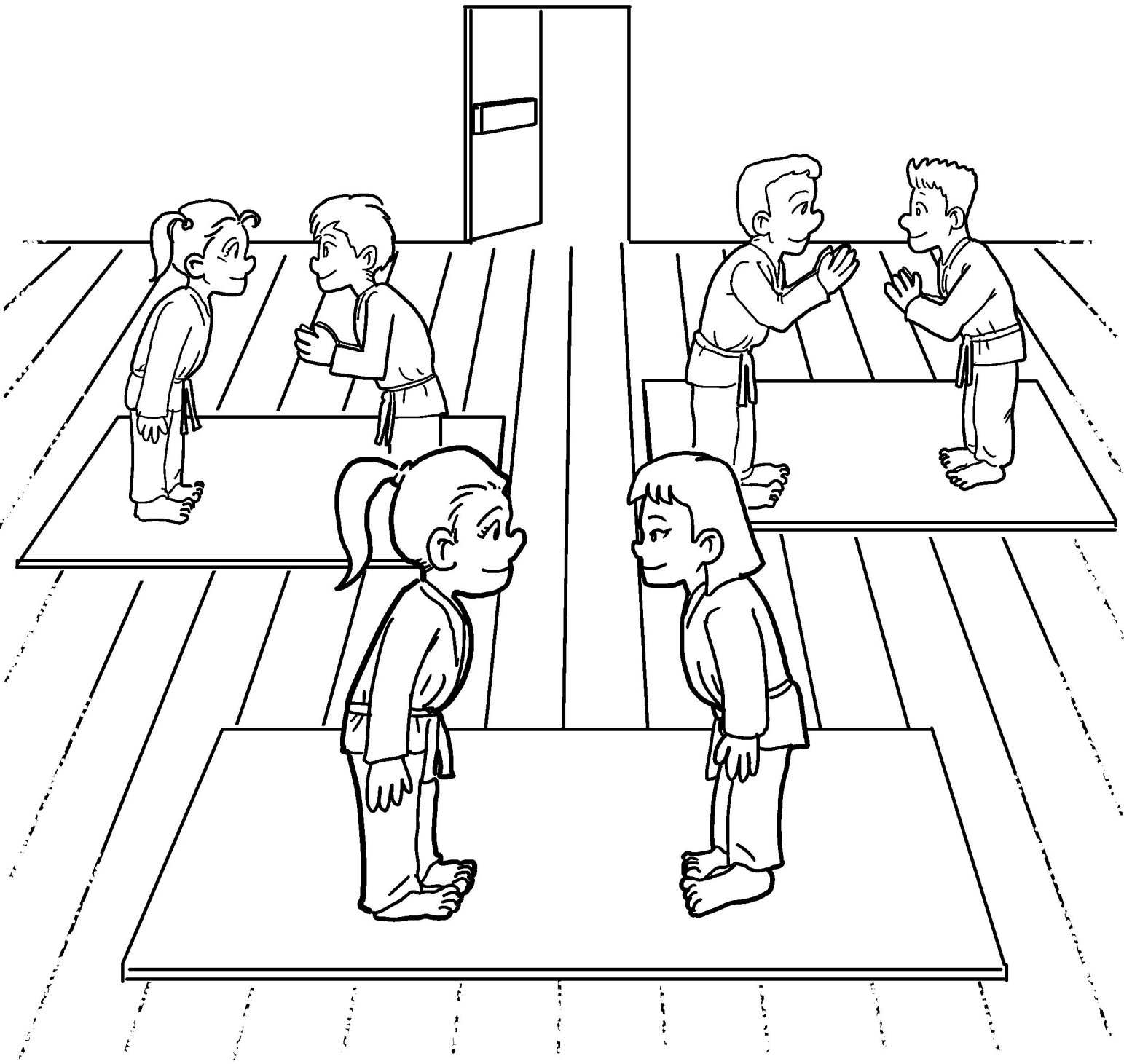
**Respect your home by keeping it clean. How many of these things do you do regularly?**

with your siblings.**



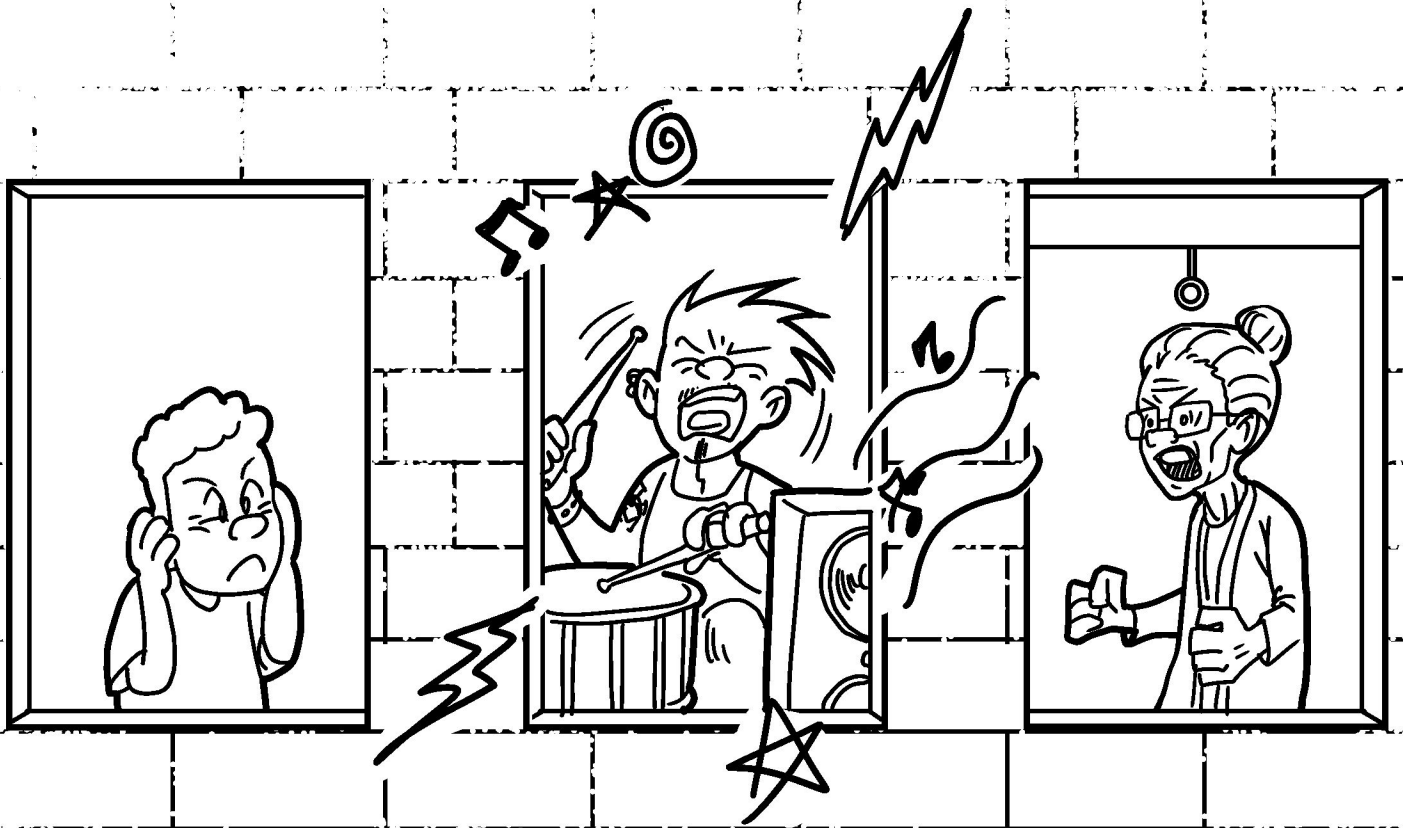
**When you visit your grandparents,

They can be fragile and tear easily.**

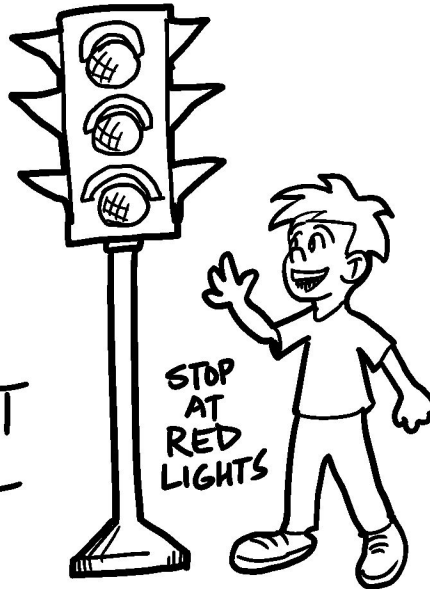

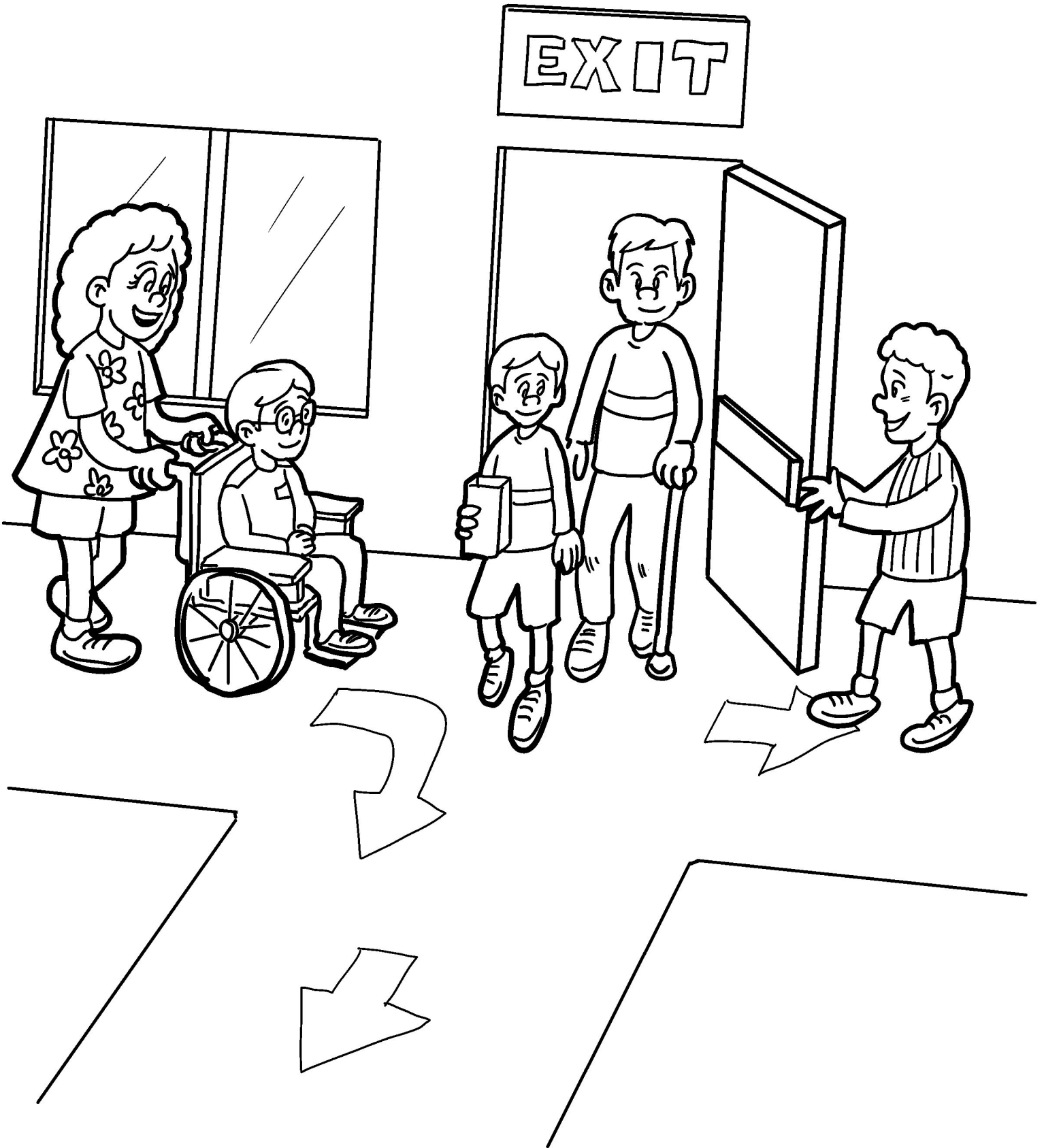
**Never let anyone feel left out. Always share what you have with others. Doing this will make you both feel great.**

sure it never touches the ground.**



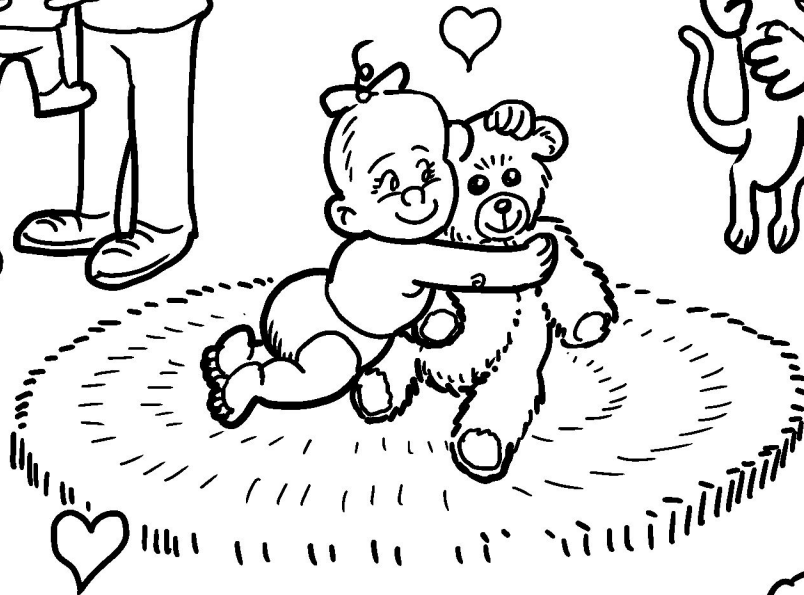
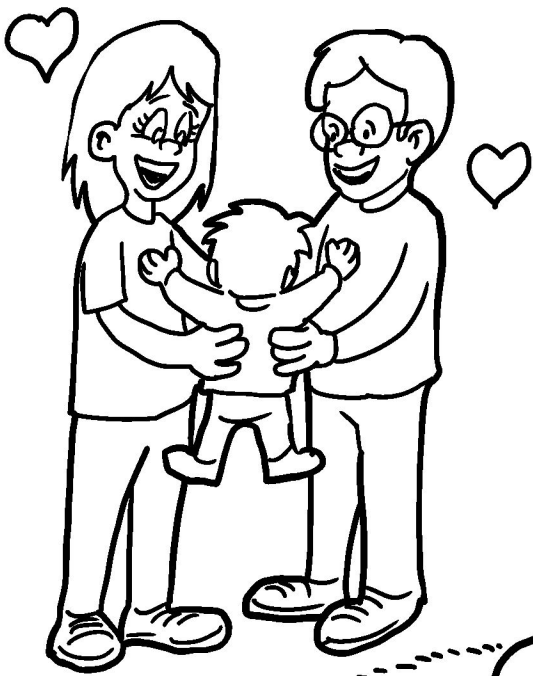
**Always respect and give your complete attention to your teacher. Be prepared to raise your hand and participate.**

is a great way to show respect.**

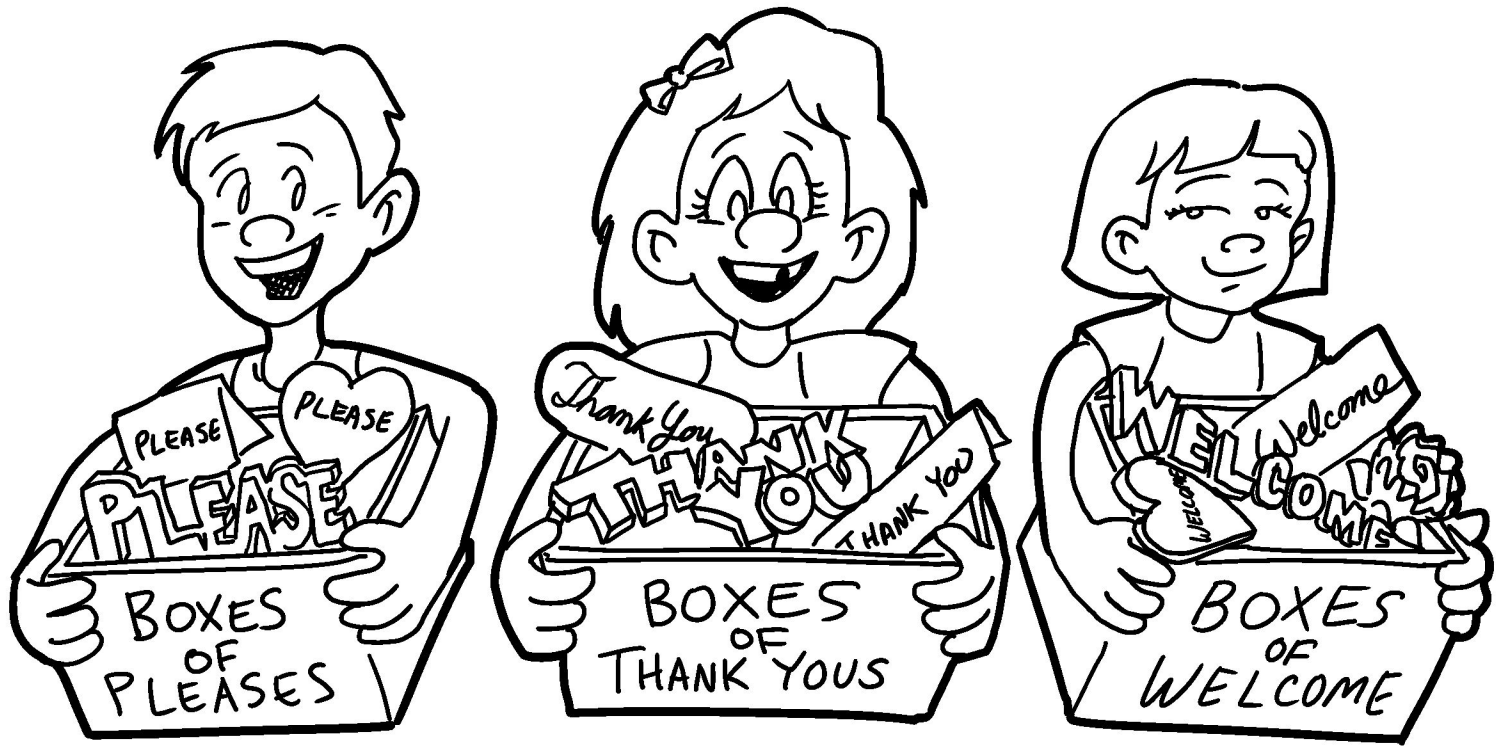


**Spend time with Grandma and Grandpa.
