








Never paint, color, or mark on someone else's property without permission.




Respect your home by keeping it clean. How many of these things do you do regularly?



Always play nice and share with your siblings.




When you visit your grandparents, take them a small gift. Think of a good question to ask, then listen to their answer. They always enjoy a good joke.

Help and treat people in need with great respect. Everyone needs a little help sometimes.




We share many of the same areas, so be respectful and considerate of your neighbors.



Be very careful with books.


They can be fragile and tear easily.



Obeying the law is a great way to show respect to your community.




Never let anyone feel left out. Always share what you have with others. Doing this will make you both feel great.

Always respect and give your complete attention to your teacher. Be prepared to raise your hand and participate.




Opening a door for someone in need is a great way to show respect.




Spend time with Grandma and Grandpa.
