

## Deputy Sheriffs Are Our Friends






When I was lost, deputy sheriffs helped find me. I know I can always trust them.

When I'm at the lake I feel safer knowing deputy sheriffs are on patrol.






The county fair is really fun but very crowded. I appreciate seeing the deputy sheriffs there. They make me feel safe.



Once, a deputy sheriff rescued my family in a helicopter. We were all so thankful.




Sometimes a deputy sheriff comes to our school to teach us how to stay safe. It is always fun, and we often get badges.

My family loves to ski. We feel safer knowing the deputy sheriffs are there and help is always nearby.




A deputy sheriff's dog is called a K-9. They are amazing and can smell 40 times better than we can.
