




Beckett and Charlie know how to play safely on the merry-go-round. They know if they try to show off, they may FALL off!

When camping, only adults should handle any fire. Never play with matches or around campfires!




Never chase balls or pets into the street. An oncoming car may be too close to stop!

Only use them with a parent's permission and remember to hang on tight!




ALWAYS use great caution around water, and definitely learn to swim as soon as you can!




Beware of plastic containers in the garage and storage areas. Many contain harmful and dangerous chemicals.
