I love seeing the police horses at the parade. They are huge!




When I was lost, a police officer helped me find my mom. I know I can always trust them.






Sometimes I see friendly police officers on bikes in the city.




Rain or shine, the police are always there to help me when I need them.

I love when Officer John brings his K-9 to the park. We all wave because we know we shouldn't pet his dog while on duty.




When I was sick and in the hospital, a police lady came to visit me.

She said she was a mom too.


BOYS & GIRLS CLUB

How many of these have you seen?




Sometimes a police officer comes to our school to teach us how to stay safe. It is always fun, and we often get badges.
